JRI Health Housing Programs

River Street Community: ______ River Street Community provides supportive services and subsidized housing for up to thirteen individuals in a Boston Housing apartment building located in Mattapan. Each of the thirteen units is efficiency or a small one — bedroom unit. Units are subsidized thought he Boston Housing Authority. River Street Staff offer ongoing support through individual service Plans and on an as-needed basis. Huntington at Symphony: ______ This program is located in a 90-unit condo building on Huntington Avenue in Boston. There are 25 efficiency units for individuals and families. All units are subsidized through the Boston Housing Authority. Staffing is available 24 hours per day. This program offers ongoing support through its housing staff. The Assisted Living Program:

This Program provides access to specially set-aside rental subsidies for individuals and

families. ALP partners with Metropolitan Boston Housing Partnership in Boston. MBHP administers rental assistance, or subsidies. ALP provides ongoing support and stabilization. Besides the Greater Boston program, ALP works with housing authorities in Plymouth Bristol County and Essex County to

work with those individuals and families through our expanded program TBRA PLUS.
