Trauma: noun

- 1) a deeply disturbing or distressing event;
- 2) emotional shock following a stressful event or physical injury;
- 3) a physical injury

Resilience: noun

- 1) the ability of a substance or object to spring back into shape; elasticity;
- 2) the capacity to recover quickly from difficulties; toughness
